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ACROSS

- 2 A sudden overwhelming fear, with or without cause
- 4 Expressing or exhibiting sharply varying emotional tones
- 7 Scales or small sheds from the coat or feathers of various animals, often of an allergenic nature
- 9 Of or relating to the windpipe
- 11 Exhausted, as by exertion; fatigued or sleepy
- 13 Relieve the symptoms of asthma by relaxing the muscle bands that tighten around the airways.
- 17 A physical sensation produced by compression of a part of the body.
- 18 A chronic disease of the airways that makes breathing difficult.
- 19 Experiencing a feeling of constriction
- 21 The fertilizing element of flowering plants, consisting of fine, powdery, yellowish grains or spores, sometimes in masses
- 22 Distress or uneasiness of mind caused by fear of danger or misfortune

- 1 To expel air from the lungs suddenly with a harsh noise, often involuntarily.
- 2 A distressing sensation in a particular part of the body
- 3 An apparatus or device used in breathing in medicinal vapors
- 5 To breathe with difficulty and with a whistling sound
- 6 Sullenly discontented; sulky; morose; ill-tempered
- 8 Any substance that produces a hypersensitive reaction in the body
- 10 Redness, swelling, pain, tenderness, heat, and disturbed function of an area of the body, esp. as a reaction of tissues to injured areas
- 11 Anything that serves as a stimulus and initiates or precipitates a reaction
- 12 Any foul or filthy substance, as mud, grime, dust, or excrement
- 13 Inhaling and exhaling in respiration
